A low pressure system will track across Ontario this weekend. Ten to 20 mm of rain are forecasted over Friday and Saturday. Night time temperatures above zero are expected for Southern Ontario on Friday with a daytime high of 5°C on Saturday. Temperatures are forecasted to remain around the freezing mark into early next week.

The mix of rain and mild temperatures melting some of the snowpack is expected to contribute to moderate increases in flow conditions, particularly in urban watercourses. The forecasted weather is not expected to lead to ice break up or flooding in rural areas.

Credit Valley Conservation is asking all residents and children to stay away from rivers, streams and other fast flowing water. Ice conditions are unsafe. Stay off ice and away from slippery slopes.

CVC will continue to closely monitor weather, water and ice conditions in the watershed. This Water Safety Statement will be in effect through Tuesday, January 14, 2014 or until further notice.
