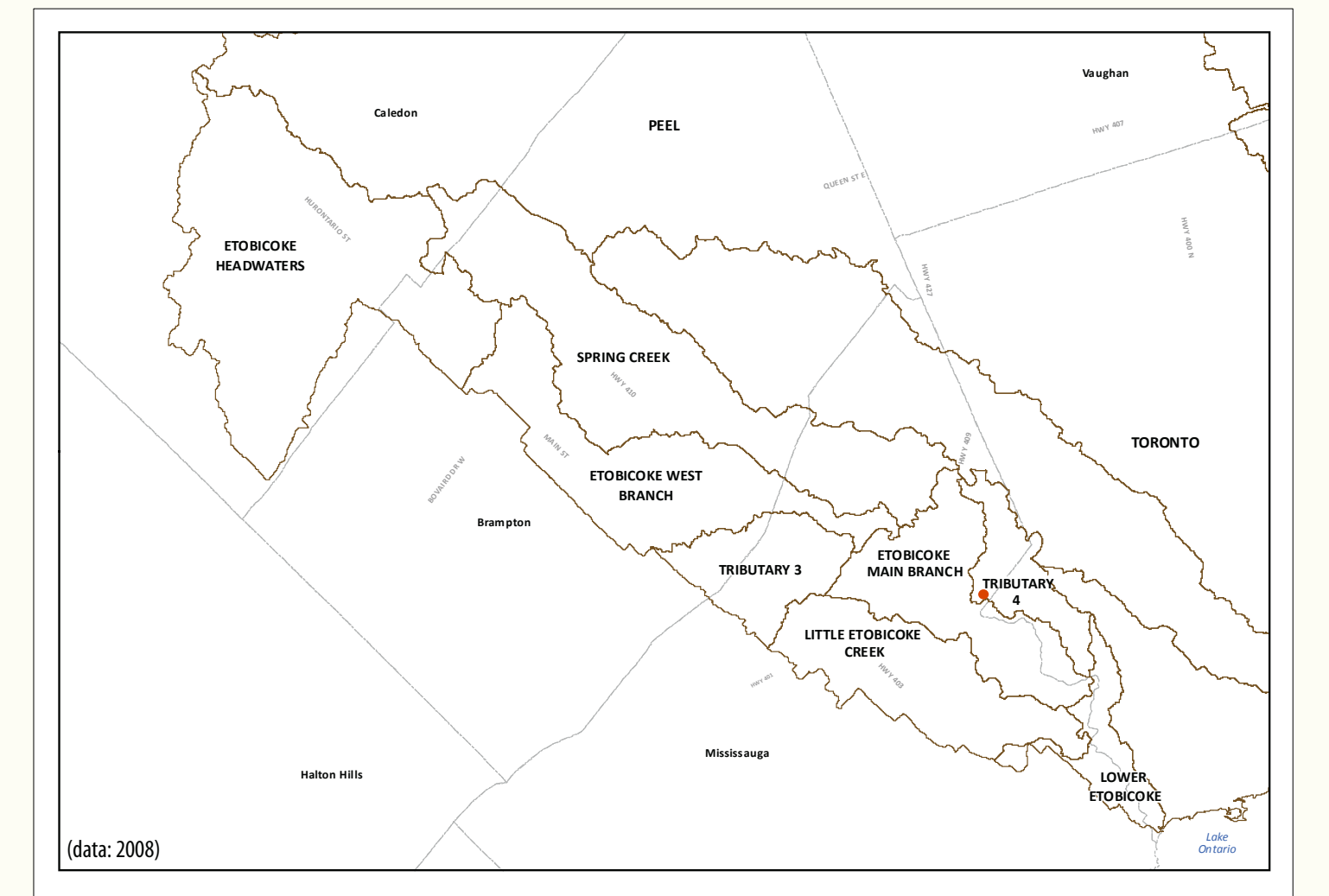


LOCATION IN ETOBICOKE CREEK WATERSHED



Etobicoke creek watershed originates on the south slope of the Oak Ridges Moraine and travels south to Lake Ontario. Together with Mimico Creek they total 28,860 hectares in size and support a population of over 400,000 people, and substantial numbers of businesses and industries.
