Credit Valley Conservation advises that Environment Canada is forecasting 10 - 20 mm of rainfall today afternoon and evening for southern Ontario, including Credit River watershed. Localized areas may see higher amounts (5 to 15 mm) due to the risk of thunderstorms.

Soil is saturated and water levels in the Credit River are slightly elevated after yesterday rain and heavy early April rainfall.

While no flooding is anticipated, localized intense rainfall may cause some minor flooding of low lying areas along the Credit River. Areas adjacent to watercourses, especially near culvers and intake structures, may become dangerous because of higher flow rates and should be avoided.

CVC will continue to closely monitor weather and water levels in the Credit River watershed. This Flood Outlook Statement will be in effect through to Friday April 21<sup>th</sup> 2017 or until further notice.
