Credit Valley Conservation advises that Environment Canada is forecasting a slight chance of a severe thunderstorm capable of producing heavy rain, hail, and strong wind gusts. Rainfall amount with in the 25-40mm range are expected. Thunderstorms are forecasted to develop this evening and continue overnight into tomorrow afternoon. Areas that receive thunderstorms may see rainfall amounts of greater than 50 mm.

All watercourses in our area will experience higher than normal water levels. As a result, local streams and rivers will become dangerous, especially in the vicinity of culverts, bridges and dams. During this time, watercourses can be dangerous for kayaking, canoeing, tubing or any other form of recreational activity. The public is urged to stay away from fast flowing water during this time.

CVC will continue to closely monitor weather and water levels in the watershed. The Flood Outlook Statement will be in effect through Monday November 6, 2017 or until further notice.
