Currently air temperatures are decreasing and tonight will reach  $-10^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $-12^{\circ}\text{C}$  in the Credit River Watershed. Below freezing temperatures are generally expected over the next week. Water levels in the Credit River and tributaries continue to slowly decline.

Cold weather is reducing the potential the remaining ice jams in the Credit River to further weaken. Localized flooding along the Credit River and its major tributaries however, may occur in low-lying areas in the vicinity of remaining ice jams. As a result, local streams, rivers, and shorelines remain dangerous, especially in the vicinity of culverts, bridges and dams. People should be warned to stay away from all watercourses, especially children and pets.

CVC will continue to closely monitor weather and water levels in the watershed. The Watershed Conditions Statement for Flood Outlook will be in effect through to Monday February 11<sup>th</sup> or until further notice.
