### Voluntary Harvest Limits

Island Lake Conservation Area and Ken Whillans Resource Management Area encourage you to follow the **Voluntary Harvest Limits** posted onsite as a fisheries management technique. This will help to ensure a sustainable healthy fishery for all to enjoy.

### Island Lake Conservation Area

Northern Pike	2nd Sat. in May to Mar. 31	Sport: 6 Conservation: 2
Largemouth Bass	4th Sat. in June to Nov. 30	Catch and Release
Pan Fish <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Black Crappie</li> <li>• Yellow Perch</li> <li>• Sunfish</li> </ul>	Open All Year	Sport: 25 Conservation: 10  Total catch of all 3 species in any combination.

### Ken Whillans Resource Management Area - ponds

Species	Open Season (during hours of operation and pond safety only)	Voluntary Harvest Limits
Northern Pike	2nd Sat. in May to Mar. 31	Sport: 6 Conservation: 2
Largemouth Bass	4th Sat. in June to Nov. 30	Catch and Release
Rainbow Trout	4th Sat. in April to Sept. 30	Catch and Release  Exception for ages under 17 and over 64:  Sport: 2 Conservation: 1

**Ken Whillans Resource Management Area – river**

<b>Species</b>	<b>Open Season (during hours of operation only)</b>	<b>Limits</b>
Rainbow Trout, Brook Trout and Brown Trout	4th Sat. in April to Sept. 30	Catch and possession limit of <b>zero</b> and <b>only artificial</b> lures (no organic bait) with <b>one single-pointed barbless</b> hook can be used
