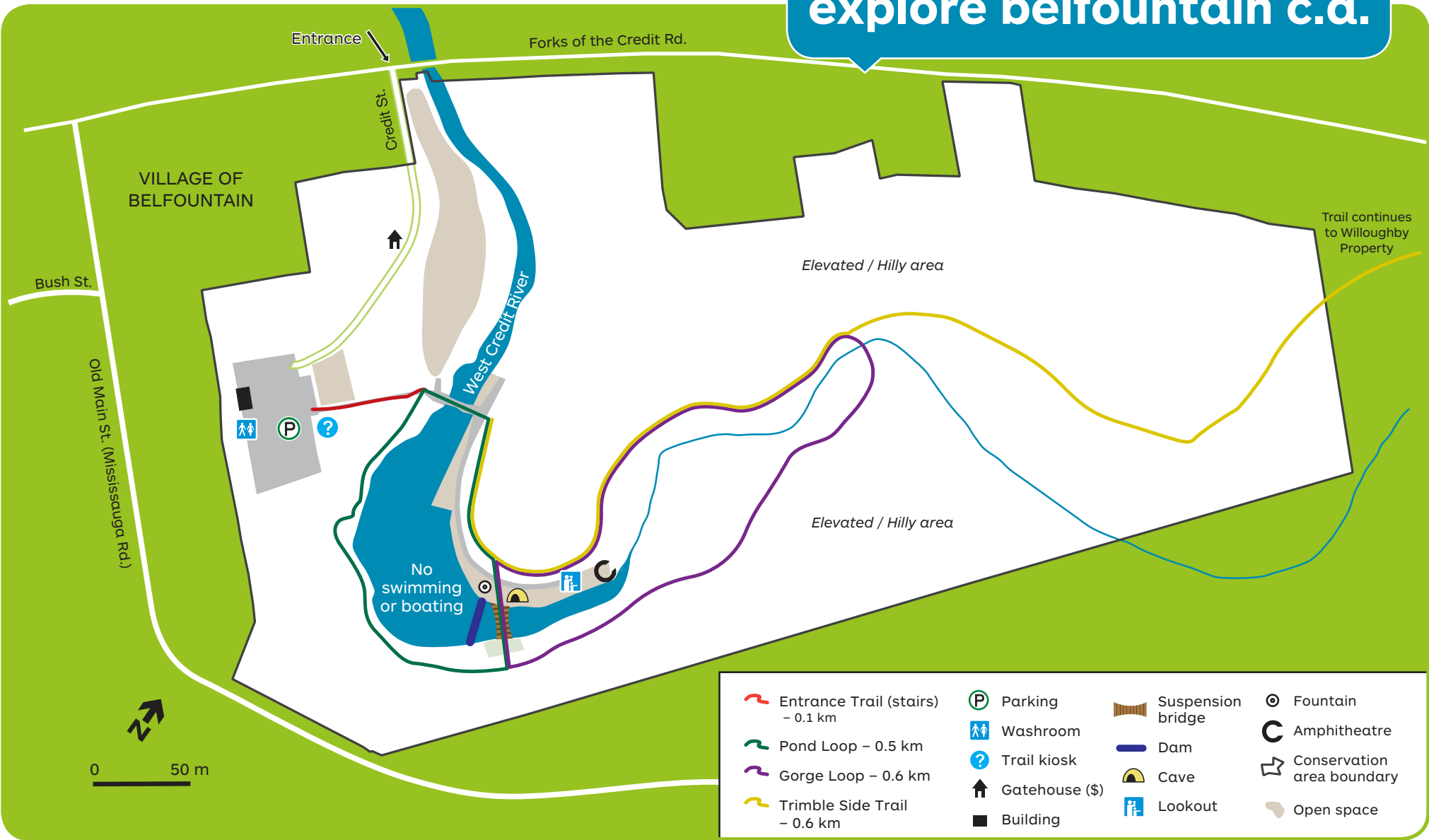


explore belfountain c.a.
