Based on precipitation and streamflow data for the period ending July 31, 2021, CVC has confirmed that the Upper Credit River Watershed remains in Level I Low Water Conditions. Island Lake levels are historically low and will continue to drop through Fall of 2021 ([more information about water levels at Island Lake](#)).

Level I Low Water Conditions have been cancelled for the entire West Credit River, Middle Credit River Watershed, and Lower Credit River Watershed.

CVC continues to closely monitor precipitation and streamflow data and assess low water conditions. This current update is in effect through August 31, 2021 or until further notice.
